***Old Exhibit B, CBA Paragraph 20 & 21 work in the counties of Ashtabula, Cuyahoga, Fulton, Geauga, Hancock, Henry, Lake, Lucas, Putnam, & Wood shall receive \$1.00 (Page 26, Adjustment for Former Exhibit B District Employees) over the going journeyman base rate for a total of \$34.74 (base rate). This additional \$1.00 to the base rate will be used for apprentices working under that work scope and within that jurisdiction. All fringe rates are paid the same for both journeymen and apprentices.**

Lead Cement Mason / Foreman rate is \$1.50 per hour more added to the base rate.

Apprentice Schedule

1st Year - 70% of Base Rate
2nd Year - 80% of Base Rate
3rd Year - 90% of Base Rate

Work performed in Local 132's jurisdiction has three separate line items: Dues of 5% of total package deduction (per hour), \$0.15 per hour deduction for Promo/Marketing, and \$0.05 per hour deduction for TAP
